4. POLICE REPORT; A full detailed statistic report was made available.

Incidents of Note;

- •Some time during April (exact date unknown), a quantity of lead flashing was stolen from the roof of Paradykes Primary School. Theft only discovered due to a leak in the school.
- On the evening of 2 April, a pony was stolen from a field at Wadingburn, the pony was later recovered in the possession of an 18 year old male in Burdiehouse. Male reported accordingly.
- Overnight 2 3 April, a motor car was stolen from Albany in Clerk Street, vehicle later recovered in West Lothian and a positive line of enquiry being followed.
- Overnight 7 8 April, £6k worth of metal was stolen from Lothian Auto Salvage, Engine Road.
- In the early hours of 9 April, attempts were made to steal 3 motor vehicles in Clerk Street/Engine Road. Enquiries ongoing.
- Overnight 11 12 April, a blue Peugeot Speedfight motorcycle was stolen from Park Avenue, Loanhead.
- On 3 separate nights in April, copper sheeting was stolen from the roof of Loanhead Social Work Centre, Clerk Street. They are currently replacing all copper with non-valuable material.
- Between 18 26 April, the Pavilion in George V Park was broken into and a telephone stolen.
- On the evening of 25 April, a bus shelter was vandalised in Lawrie Terrace, a 14 year old female has been reported for this offence.

Again this summer we have an initiative running to target anti-social use of Off-Road Motor Cycles (Operation Estate).

The Chair reported that the memorial erected to commemorate a visit to Loanhead by the Queen 50 years ago has been stolen. The ornate sundial sculpture has sat in Loanhead Memorial Park Gardens since 1962. The sundial was taken on Wednesday 4th May night or Thursday morning, and police have appealed for anyone with information to get in touch. It is likely to have been stolen for scrap. The Chair added that it was very, very sad.
